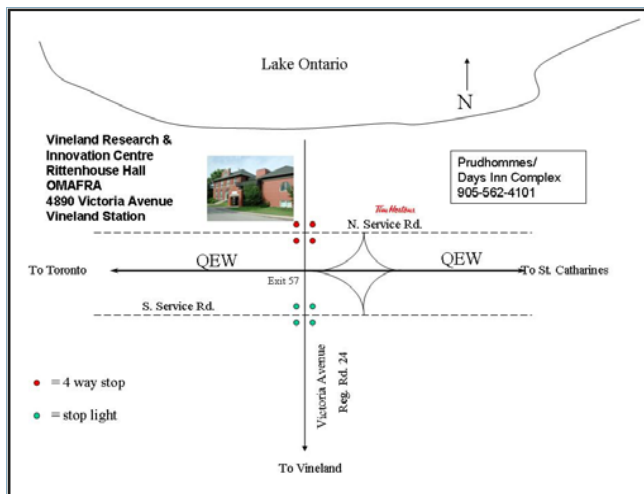

### Directions from Hamilton:

Take QEW Niagara. Exit at Victoria Avenue, Vineland exit. At the end of the off-ramp merge to the right with the South Service Road. Proceed on South Service Road to stop light at Victoria Avenue (almost right away). Turn right at the stop light and proceed over the overpass (over QEW toward Lake Ontario). At the bottom of the overpass there is a 4-way stop at the North Service Road. Continue through the intersection and take the first left into the Research Station – watch for the Vineland Research & Innovation Centre sign on the corner. Continue down the driveway and over the stone bridge – then keep to the right. Ontario Government Building with Rittenhouse Hall in the lower level is on the left with parking in front on the right.

### Directions from St. Catharines:

Take QEW Toronto. Exit at Victoria Avenue Vineland exit. At the end of the off-ramp turn left at the stop light. Continue on Service Road to 4-way stop at Victoria Avenue (almost right away). Turn right onto Victoria Avenue and turn left almost immediately into the Research Station driveway - watch for the Vineland Research & Innovation Centre sign on the corner. Continue down the driveway and over the stone bridge – then keep to the right. Ontario Government Building with Rittenhouse Hall in the lower level is on the left with parking in front on the right.
