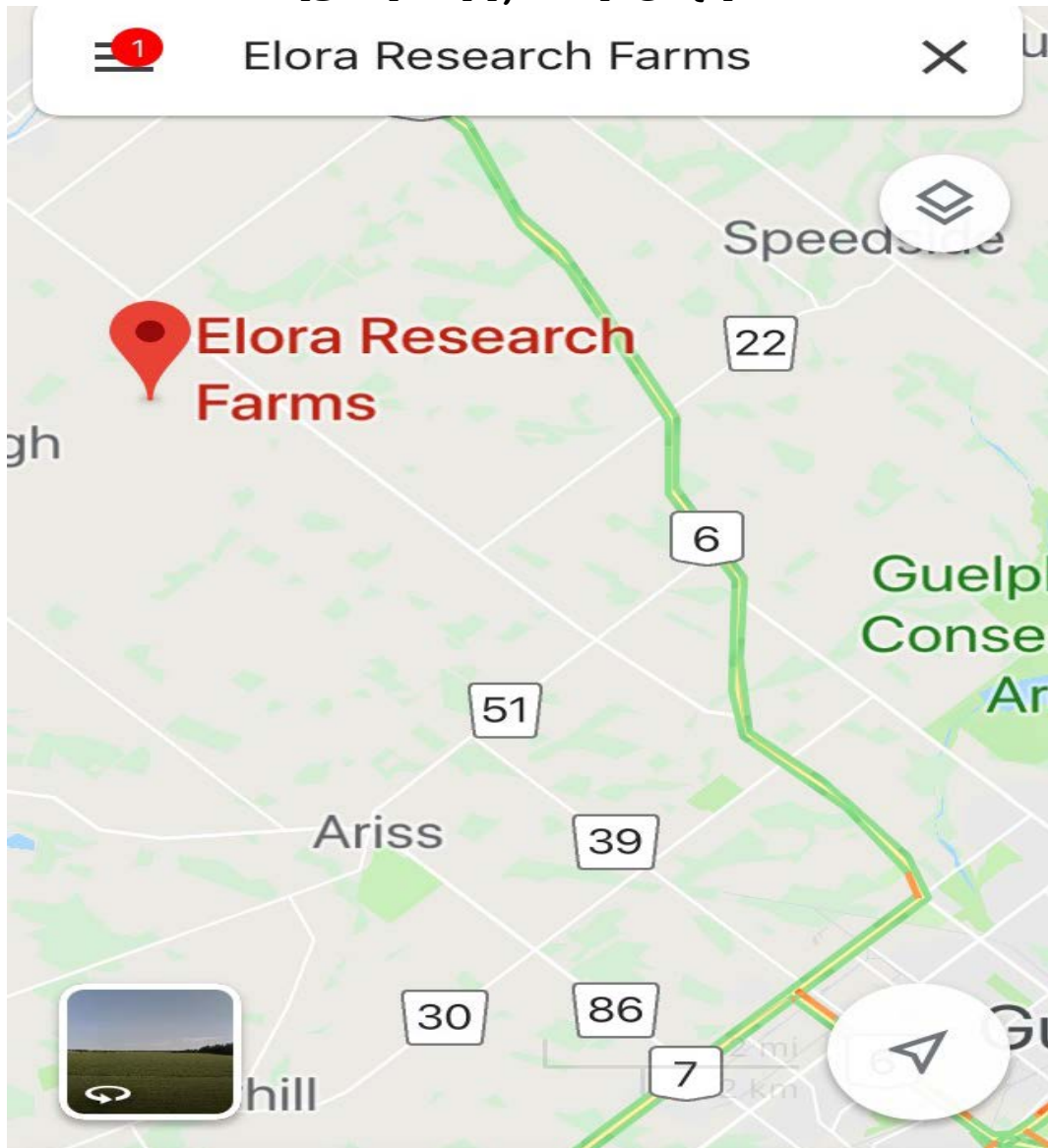

From Elora: take the Elora Road (Hwy 7) towards Guelph. Take the first right after "Webfoot Farms". Take your first left. Drive past the beef station and the **Crops Building** is on your right.

From Guelph: Take Hwy 6 out of town. Pass Marden. Turn left on the road to Elora (Hwy 7). Take Wellington Road #7 for 5 km until you reach Ponsonby Public School on your right. Take the next left. Then turn right at the first intersection. The **Crops Building** will be 4 km on your left.
